



How to Register: Convenient online registration on our website: www.birchwoodcamp.org. Contact our office for a paper registration form.

Camp Fee Details: All camp registrations require a \$25 non-refundable deposit; refund policies are available on our website. Register online before February 28th and receive a \$10 discount per camper. *First 10 campers total to register will receive a free Birchwood Camp gift.* A variety of payment plans are available so you can spread out your fee payments over several months. A \$20 late fee applies to registrations received within 10 days of the session start.

Scholarships: We believe the camp experience is invaluable and should be available to your child regardless of your family's financial situation. Use our scholarship form (available online or contact us) to request financial assistance. Partial & full scholarships are available on a first come, first served basis.

A Note about Fees: Your camper's experience is possible because of the generosity of supporters committed to camping ministries. Our camp activities- worship, games, crafts, swimming, singing, boating, skits, stand up paddle boarding, Bible study, hiking, campfires & more- are designed for experiential learning and building intentional community.

Through these experiences, campers will develop character, make new friends, deepen their faith, try new things, and gain an appreciation for God's world
